National Office Letter regarding Club Fees and Drawdowns

Dear Apexians,

There has been quite a lot of questions asked in the last few weeks regarding drawdowns and fees of the association. The following information will, answer a lot of the questions asked and is general info for all of our members.

How are our fees Calculated? National fees are calculated for the financial year on a per capita (cost per member) and per clubita (cost per club) basis. These amounts are calculated when the budget is prepared and are directly related to the annual cost of running the association. It is important to note that the biggest cost and majority of annual fees is our insurances, which are a must if the Association is to continue.

This years fees will be:

\$ 1,330.00 per Clubita

\$ 60.00 per Capita

You can work out roughly what your Club's National fees will be by multiple the number in the club and add the per Clubita. The accuracy of the invoice when your Club receives it is directly related to the information we have on your club in the Database. Therefore, please get your Club Census in as soon as possible (admin@apex.org.au) or else we will be charging of the existing information.

There has been some confusion in the last 12months, in regards to invoicing and when the drawdowns took place. For this we apologise. Good News! This year's is well in hand.

When will our Club be charged for it's National Fees?

Your Club's invoice will go out by the middle of September. The Invoice will have the Club's total National fees for the financial year. The invoice will also state the dates and amounts for the four drawdowns.

These will be:

Last week of September,2021.

Last week of December, 2021.

Last week of March, 2022.

Last week of June, 2022.
