



Philippines Bursary Audit

Preamble

It is with great honour that I present my third Bursary Audit for the Philippines. Now in its 45th year of providing education and development to some of the greatest scholars in the Philippines, the scheme continues to show success and growth. I have always believed that the most important factor of this is the partnership between Apex Philippines and Apex Australia. Apexian's in the Philippines provide on the ground support to the scholars and in most cases the Club Bursary Officers become mentors to their allocated scholars.

Clubs with scholars are: Batangas, San Pablo, Iloilo, Leganes and Passi. As of planning during last Audit, two years ago, San Pablo Womens Club had been operating for over two year and as of the start of this year have taken on the responsibility of their first two scholars.

The scholar's funds from sponsors, once transferred to the Philippines from Australia, are held in trust and distributed from a local bank account. This account and funds distribution is overseen by a local group of five Trustees. 2 months ago, one of these trustees unfortunately passed away. The National Board of Apex Philippines in consultation with myself have appointment a replacement trustee, Domingo Raymundo (Domz). Domz is a great Apexian with a long history of being involved in the Bursary.

The Future

The future for The Overseas bursary in the Philippines looks the brightest that I have seen in my time as Bursary Officer. Apex Philippines has a vibrance and every club I visited were talking about increased membership, reactivating clubs and new clubs. Batangas Womens Club has now been running for over two years and are keen to have their first two scholars placed as soon as we can and are actively collecting applications.

I also met with the Immediate Past National President, Rommel Caranto. He is a member of Los Banos Club. Los Banos was inactive for 8 years and now has been active again for three years and produced a National President. He expressed interest on behalf of his club to become involved in the Bursary and to start their first two scholars.

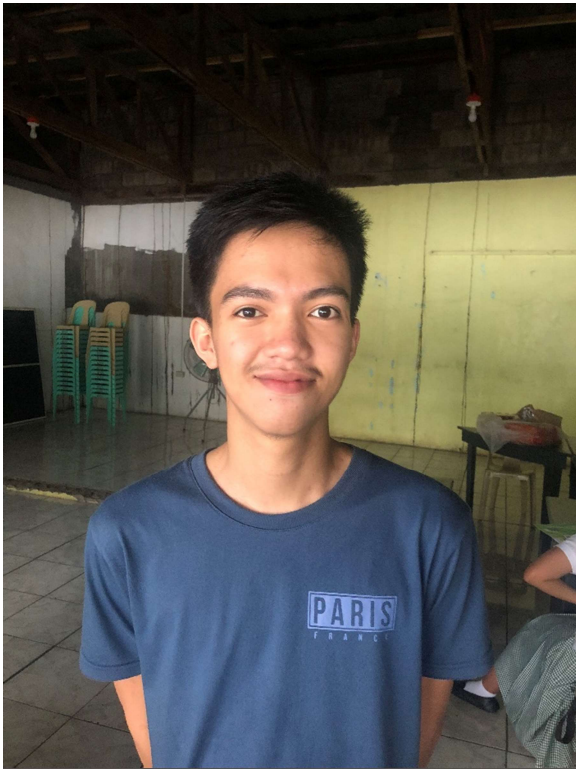
